**No. PR/194/13-DD/225/13/DC/587/2017.**—In terms of the provisions of Section 21B(3) of the Chartered Accountants Act, 1949 read with Rules 18(17) and 19(1) of the Chartered Accountants (Procedure of Investigations of Professional and Other Misconduct and Conduct of Cases) Rules, 2007, the Disciplinary Committee has held **CA. Ganapathy Sivaprakash (Membership No. 024556), No. 5 (Old No. 2), 5<sup>th</sup> Cross Street, West Shenoy Nagar, CHENNAI- 600 030**, guilty of Professional Misconduct falling within the meaning of Clauses (6), (7) and (8) of Part I of Second Schedule to the aforesaid Act and consequently ordered for removal of name of **CA. Ganapathy Sivaprakash (Membership No. 024556)** from the Register of Members for a period of 02(Two) years. In pursuance of the aforesaid Order of the Disciplinary Committee and in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 20 of the aforesaid Act, read with Regulation 18 of the Chartered Accountants Regulations 1988, the name of **CA. Ganapathy Sivaprakash (Membership No. 024556) was removed from the Register of Members for a period of 02(Two) years with effect from 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2022.** Aggrieved by Order of the Committee, the Respondent preferred an Appeal in terms of Section 22G of the Chartered Accountants Act, 1949 and the Appellate Authority vide its order pronounced on 11<sup>th</sup> October, 2022 had modified the period of removal of name from 02(two) years to 01(one) year. Accordingly, in pursuance of the said order of the Appellate Authority, the notification dated 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2022 wherein the name of **CA. Ganapathy Sivaprakash (Membership No. 024556)** was removed from the Register of Members for a period of 2(two) years is hereby modified to the extent that the name of **CA. Ganapathy Sivaprakash (Membership No. 024556) stands removed for a period of 01(one) year instead of 02(two) years w.e.f. 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2022.**
